Sports Premium 2013 - 2014

Impact of the Sports Premium

- 1) More children want to take part in festivals/competition e.g. 46 children tried out for the dodge ball team.
- 2) A wider variety of festivals have been offered to children (see below)
- 3) Wider variety of clubs during and after school e.g. energy club, rounders, dodge ball, running club.
- 4) Children enjoying competitive side of sport e.g. older children wanted a more competitive sports day.
- 5) Positive feedback from parents regarding the raised profile of sport throughout the school.

- 6) At festivals other schools have commented to PE leader that 'Tickford is becoming one of the schools to beat!
- 7) Due to the school's success lots of children are joining out of school clubs e.g. Running, hockey, football clubs
- 8) Every teacher has attended PE CPD course - PE Leader carried out PE observations with MKSSP, therefore the standard of teaching and learning has risen.
- 9) PE apprentice has ensured that PE lessons are fully inclusive and differentiated for children with physical needs; these children now have a greater enjoyment of PE and increased confidence in PE lessons.
- 10) Equipment is kept in good condition (Balls pumped up, in the right place etc.) and is now easily available for lessons.
- 11) PE apprentice leads the Play Leaders (Y5 children) this has increased children's physical participation during lunchtime.
- 12) PE apprentice is able to run training sessions within schools - this had led to greater success in festivals and competitions.
